### Course overview

■ Duration: 3 months (extension of the course available)

■ Classes: From Monday to Friday (5 days per week)

Morning classes from 9:15 to 12:30/Afternoon classes from 13:30 to 16:45

※Class time depends on level

■ Fees: Registration Fee 10,000 JPY, Tuition Fee 180,000 JPY (exclusive of textbooks costs) ※Textbooks changes from class to class

■ Requirements: Applicants must be 16 years old or more

■ How to apply: Fill in the relevant application form and submit a photograph

■ Level: From Beginner to Advanced

[Beginner] Acquire minimum level of proficiency to live in Japan.

[Elementary] Everyday conversation level. Ability to understand basic grammar and express simple ideas.

[Intermediate] No troubles in everyday conversation. Growth of personal vocabulary. Proficiency level allows the speaker to attend a Vocational school.

[Advanced] No troubles in conversation with native speakers. Proficiency allows the speaker to attempt a University entrance exam.

- School events & Exams:
- Every 3 months of the course there are field trips and/or school events. Also, in the final period of the course, we will hold in school events and presentations of the classwork's.
  - · Students take an achievement test every week, and an end of term test at the end of the course.
- Certificate: With a minimum attendance rate of 80%, students receive a completion certificate at the end of the course.

#### Accommodation

We work in partnership with accommodation facilities such as share houses, dormitories and even homestay, easily accessible from the school (please note that according to room vacancy condition, we might not be able to introduce the exact property).

## II. Cancellation policy

## Applications from abroad

[ [Cancellation before the course starts]

Any cancellation request must be submitted in written form (email).

The school replies to all messages, therefore kindly double-check in case there is no answer from the school's side. Once paid, the registration fee cannot be refunded. For cancellations after the course has started, the following cancellation charges apply, regardless of the reason, Bank fees related to tuition refund are at receiver's charge.

Cancellation date	Cancellation charge
31 days before the course starts	No charge
From 30 to 15 days before the course starts	10% of tuition
From 14 to 6 days before the course starts	20% of tuition
From 5 days to 1 days before the course starts	50% of tuition
The day the course starts or no-show	100% of tuition %

[Cancellation after the course has started or course change]

No refund or change is possible after the course has started.

## **Applications within Japan** \*\*Only for people with a residence permit longer than 6 months

[Cancellation before the course starts]

A cancellation charge of 15,000 JPY would be deducted upon refund of registration fee and tuition.

[Cancellation after the course has started]

Registration fee and tuition would be refunded after deducting relevant cancellation charge and tuition fees corresponding to the classes already taken (or school days that have passed since the beginning of the course). Cancellation charge corresponds to 20% of tuition (maximum limit 50,000 JPY)

[About Cooling-off]

New applicants who enroll from within Japan have a period of 8 days in which they are allowed to cancel the application, in written form (cooling-off). In this case, no cancellation charge is deducted and registration fee is fully refunded.
